Discover Orval through the centuries.

A visit to the ruins of the old Cistercian Abbey is an opportunity to discover a place with a wealth of history and beauty deep in a valley where the Mathilde fountain gushes.

An illustrated tour, the museum housed in 18th-century cellars, the traditional pharmacy with its garden of medicinal plants. Abraham buildings: Exhibition about the brewing in Orval and the work of the monk painter Brother Abraham Gilson, complete the visit.

In the Abbey Shop: cheese and beer produced at the monastery, bookshop section, religious items and other souvenirs from Orval.

Orval Nature Reserve, educational outing.

Situated 200 metres from the Abbey "A l'Ange Gardien" (The Guardian Angel): Orval cheese and beer tasting.


